This **Vallejo Family Resource Guide** was inspired, in part, by the cadets of the Robbin Mackbee Firefighter/EMS Youth Academy's "Elementary School Fire Prevention and Safety Program", featuring "Sparky the Fire Dog". The members of the academy focus on academic achievement, community service and self-discipline. This guide is one example of the community service activities that our student/cadets of Vallejo and Jesse Bethel High School have inspired. The mission is an effort by youth to teach children in Vallejo how to be safe. Each child will be given this guide to take home.
